

# Achillea (Yarrow)

## 72ct Plug

Container:

Trade 1 Gallon Container

Finish:

8-10 weeks

When To Plant:

Summer to fall or late winter  
to late spring

## Grade #1 Bare Root

Container:

Premium 1 Gallon Pot

Finish:

6-8 weeks

When To Plant:

Late winter to late spring

## Growing Temperature:

60-65° F

## Soil pH:

5.5-6.2

## Fertility:

Feed with 50-75 ppm at every other watering. Do not over-fertilize; achillea are not heavy feeders.

## Pests and Diseases:

Root-knot nematode, Asiatic garden beetle, caterpillars, oriental beetle

Crown gall, powdery mildew, rot (Rhizoctonia), stem rot, dodder, root rots

## Planting Level:

Plant crown even with soil line.

## Lighting:

Bulk plants under short days to prevent early flowering. Achillea flower best under long days.

## Holding Temperature:

50-60° F

## EC Level:

1.5-2.5 pour through method

## Vernalization:

Beneficial at 10 weeks of temperatures below 40° F.

## Potting and Timing:

Root Trimming: Roots may be trimmed to fit pot. Some growers pinch back the original shoot after the roots have formed to encourage branching.

## Moisture:

Allow plants to dry thoroughly between waterings.

## PGRs/Pinching:

Apply multiple applications of B-Nine (Daminozide) at 2,500 ppm or a tank mixture of B-Nine at 2000 ppm and Sumagic (Uniconazole) at 3 ppm.
