

Andropogon (Big Bluestem)

30ct Plug

Container:

Premium 1 Gallon Pot

Finish:

6-8 weeks summer

8-10 weeks spring

When To Plant:

Summer to late summer or
spring

Growing Temperature:

68-75° F

Soil pH:

5.8-6.5

Fertility:

Feed moderately with 100-150 ppm N at each watering or a medium rate of controlled release fertilizer.

Potting and Timing:

It is best to plant warm season grasses in the summer as they perform much better in warm temperatures than under cooler temperatures. Large plugs can be planted in the spring but require warm greenhouse temperatures and longer bulking times.

Lighting:

Long days are required to force into flower. High light levels are recommended.

Holding Temperature:

50-60° F

EC Level:

2.0-3.0 pour through method

Vernalization:

Provide 10-12 weeks of temperatures below 45° F.

Pests and Diseases:

Aphids, mites, and caterpillars are the most common pests. Wet conditions can cause crown and root rot.

Moisture:

Moderate moisture

Planting Level:

Top of plug slightly below soil line.
