

Armeria (Thrift)

30ct Plug

Container:

Trade 1 Gallon Container

Finish:

8-10 weeks

When To Plant:

Late winter to spring

72ct Plug

Container:

Trade 1 Gallon Container

Finish:

10-12 weeks to bulk before
vernalizing

When To Plant:

Late summer, for following
spring sales

Growing Temperature:

60-65° F

Soil pH:

5.8-6.5

Fertility:

Feed very lightly as Armeria can be extremely salt sensitive. 50 ppm at each watering is optimum.

Pests and Diseases:

Crown rots(Sclerotium) from winter wet and poor drainage, rust(Uromyces).

Moisture:

Moderate moisture to slightly dry.

Planting Level:

Crown even with soil line.

Holding Temperature:

50-60° F

EC Level:

1.0-1.5 pour through method

Vernalization:

8 - 10 weeks of cold temperatures helps increase the flower performance and overall habit.

Potting and Timing:

Avoid planting too deep.

Armeria is small and is best in quarts or trade 1 gallon containers.

Use a media with good drainage.

Lighting:

High light levels are required for best growth.

Grower Tips:

Monitor the pH and EC levels regularly to avoid root damage and plant loss. If needed, flush out salts with clear water.
