Container:

Trade 1 Gallon Container

Finish:

10-12 weeks

When To Plant:

Late winter to spring

Grade #1 Bare Root

Container:

Trade 1 Gallon Container

Finish:

8-10 weeks

When To Plant:

Late winter to spring

Grade #2 Bare Root

Container:

Trade 1 Gallon Container

Finish:

10-12 weeks

When To Plant:

Late winter to spring

Growing Temperature:

55-60° F

Soil pH:

5.5-6.0

Fertility:

If grown in fertile, moist soil the plant height is more than 12" and clumps tend to open in the center. Fertilization is not recommended.

Potting and Timing:

Bare root plants may need to be trimmed to fit into containers.

Growing at temperatures higher than 75° F will cause the plant to "melt-out" and lose their soft mounded habit.

Planting Level:

Place crown just below soil line.

Lighting:

Requires high light levels for best results.

Holding Temperature:

40-50° F

EC Level:

1.0-1.5 pour through method

Vernalization:

Not required but is beneficial for plant vigor.

Pests and Diseases:

Aphids and whitefly.

Downy mildew, root, stem and crown rot, rust.

Moisture:

Requires low moisture levels, plants do not like to be wet.

Water in well at planting time, water again when soil is dry.

PGRs/Pinching:

It is best to grow Artemisia cool and dry to keep plants compact and healthy. Provide proper spacing to avoid plants growing into each other.

Grower Tips:

Plants will rot if over-wintered too wet. Good airflow is required in growing area to keep the foliage dry.



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
