Grade #1 Bare Root

Finish:

2 seasons in ground before plants yield a good crop.

When To Plant:

Early to mid spring

Notes

Asparagus require a planting depth of 6". We recommend a very deep container or to plant directly in ground.

Growing Temperature:

50-55° F

Fertility:

In early spring, when mulch is removed, 10-10-10 can be applied and scatched into the top two inches of soil.

Moisture:

Moderate moisture with good drainage.

Lighting:

Full sun

Soil pH:

6.0-6.5

Potting and Timing:

Bare root Asparagus is best planted directliy into the ground in trenches with the crown 6 inches deep.

Planting Level:

Crown 6 inches below soil line.

Grower Tips:

Asparagus may take a couple seasons before a yield can be expected.
