

# Belamcanda (Blackberry Lily)

## Grade #1 Bare Root

Container:

Premium 1 Gallon Pot

Finish:

7-9 weeks

When To Plant:

Plant in late winter to spring

## Growing Temperature:

62-65° F

## Soil pH:

6.0-6.5

## Fertility:

Belamcanda is a light to moderate feeder. Provide a liquid feed at 75-125 ppm at each watering. For Controlled Release or Slow Release Fertilizer, see your preferred supplier for recommended rates for incorporation or top dressing, as it varies by fertilizer.

## Moisture:

Keep plants moderately moist.

## Lighting:

Long days required to flower. High light levels are best.

## Holding Temperature:

55-60° F

## EC Level:

2.0-3.0

## Vernalization:

Bare root plants that are shipped in spring will arrive vernalized.

## Pests and Diseases:

Mites, aphids, and thrips can be seen feeding on Belamcanda.

## Potting and Timing:

Late winter to spring planting is recommended.

## Planting Level:

Plant bare root tubers slightly below the soil line in the container.
