Container: Trade 1 Gallon Container Finish: 6-8 weeks When To Plant: Spring Notes: Only size available in 20ct is 'Ascot Rainbow'

72ct Plug

Container: Trade 1 Gallon Container Finish: Summer 8 - 10 weeks
Spring 12-14 weeks When To Plant: Summer to late summer or spring

Grade #1 Bare Root

Container: Trade 1 Gallon Container Finish: 6-8 weeks When To Plant: Late winter to spring

Growing Temperature:

65-70° F

Soil pH:

5.8-6.5

Fertility:

Light to moderate feed rates of 50-100 ppm N at each watering are recommended.

For Controlled Release or Slow Release Fertilizer, see your preferred supplier for recommended rates for incorporation or top dressing, as it varies by fertilizer.

Potting and Timing:

Plant small plugs in late summer for proper bulking prior to vernalization.

Bare root is the best choice for spring planted crops.

Lighting:

Daylength neutral

Holding Temperature:

50-60° F

EC Level:

1.5-2.5 pour through method

Vernalization:

Plugs planted in the summer should be vernalized after bulking for 8-10 weeks at temperatures below 45° F.

Bare root plants will arrive vernalized.

Pests and Diseases:

Aphids, caterpillars, mealybugs, spider mites and whiteflies. Root and crown rot

Moisture:

Moderate moisture

Planting Level:

Crown at soil line or top of plug level with soil line.

PGRs/Pinching:

Piccolo or Bonzi (paclobutrazol) at 30 ppm, Sumagic (uniconazole) at 5 ppm or Topflor (flurprimidol) at 45 ppm. Multiple applications at 7 day intervals may be required especially in the south.
