Container: Premium 1 Gallon Pot Finish: 10-12 weeks When To Plant: Late summer Notes: Plant small plugs in late summer, then vernalize.

# Grade #1 Bare Root

Container: Premium 1 Gallon Pot Finish: 6-8 weeks When To Plant: Late winter to spring

# **Growing Temperature:**

60-65° F

# Soil pH:

5.8-6.5

# Fertility:

Feed 100-150 ppm N at each watering.

## Pests and Diseases:

Aphids, thrip, and spider mites are the main pests of Penstemon.

Crown and root rots can be problematic if grown under improper conditions. A fungicide drench is recommended after planting bare root.

# **Planting Level:**

Plant crown even with soil line.

# Lighting:

High light levels produce the best looking plants. Direct sunlight outdoors is best for achieving the proper foliage color. Flowers under natural daylengths.

# **Holding Temperature:**

50-60° F

## EC Level:

1.5-2.5 pour through method

## Vernalization:

Provide 8 weeks of temperatures below 40° F.

## Potting and Timing:

Plant small plugs in late summer for bulking purposes.

Bare root is best for quick turn spring crops or larger containers such as 2-3 gallon.

## Moisture:

Moderate moisture

## **PGRs/Pinching:**

Daminozide (B-Nine/Dazide) at 2500 ppm or paclobutrazole (Bonzi) at 5-10 ppm are effective at controlling elongation.
