#### **Growing Temperature:**

62-68° F

## Soil pH:

5.8-6.2

# Fertility:

Feed moderately with 75 - 125 ppm N at each watering.

For Controlled Release or Slow Release Fertilizer, see your preferred supplier for recommended rates for incorporation or top dressing, as it varies by fertilizer.

#### Moisture:

Moderate moisture is best. Water thoroughly and then allow plants to dry slighlty. Avoid wet conditions.

## **Planting Level:**

Crown at soil line or top of plug level with soil line.

#### **Holding Temperature:**

50-60° F

#### EC Level:

1.5-2.5 pour through method

#### **Vernalization:**

Provide 8 - 10 weeks of cold for best flowering performance.

#### **Pests and Diseases:**

Aphids, thrip, and spider mites are most common. Root and crown rot can be problematic under wet growing conditions or if planted too deep.

#### **Potting and Timing:**

Plant plugs in late summer for proper bulking time. Bare root is the best option for spring.

If small plugs are purchased in spring, plant them in a 1 quart container rather than a 1 gallon.

### Lighting:

Long days required for flowering. High light levels are best.
