

Yucca (Adam's Needle)

72ct Plug

Container:

Premium 1 Gallon Pot

Finish:

8-10 weeks

When To Plant:

Spring

Grade #1 Bare Root

Container:

Premium 1 Gallon Pot

Finish:

6-8 weeks

When To Plant:

Early to late spring

Growing Temperature:

65-75° F

Soil pH:

5.8-6.2

Fertility:

Feed moderately at 75 - 100 ppm N at each watering.

For Controlled Release or Slow Release Fertilizer, see your preferred supplier for recommended rates for incorporation or top dressing, as it varies by fertilizer.

Potting and Timing:

Plant bare root plants in early to late spring. Plants are evergreen so they will arrive with foliage on them.

Lighting:

Yucca prefer high light levels for best growth.

Holding Temperature:

50-60° F

EC Level:

1.5-2.5

Pests and Diseases:

Thrip, scale, mealybugs, and weevils are the main pests on yucca.

The most commonly seen diseases are Coniothyrium or brown leaf spot (*Coniothyrium concentricum*), Cytosporina or gray leaf spot (*Cytosporina* sp.), Fusarium stem rot (*Fusarium* spp.) and Southern Blight (*Sclerotium*).

Moisture:

Moderate moisture is best. Avoid overwatering.

Planting Level:

Plant with the crown at soil line. Tubers should not be exposed.

Grower Tips:

Bare root plants are large. Use a true 1 gallon container instead of a trade 1 gallon.

Some growers prefer using a 2 gallon container to allow plenty of room for the large, tuberous roots.
