Feed moderatly at 75 - 100 ppm N at each watering.

Potting and Timing:


Plant bare root plants in early to late spring. Plants are evergreen so they will arrive with foliage on them.

Lighting:

Yucca prefer high light levels for best growth.

Grower Tips:

Bare root plants are large. Use a true 1 gallon container instead of a trade 1 gallon.





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Holding Temperature:

50-60° F

EC Level:

1.5-2.5

Pests and Diseases:

Thrip, scale, mealybugs, and weevils are the main pests on yucca.

The most commonly seen diseases are Coniothyrium or brown leaf spot (*Coniothyrium concentricum*), Cytosporina or gray leaf spot (*Cytosporina* sp.), Fusarium stem rot (*Fusarium* spp.) and Southern Blight (Sclerotium).

Moisture:

Moderate moisture is best. Avoid overwatering.

Planting Level:

Plant with the crown at soil line. Tubers should not be exposed.
